



## **LIVESTREAMING OF MASS AND OTHER LITURGIES IN THE PARISH OF OUR LADY OF LOURDES & ST DOMINIC SAVIO**

**We use livestreaming on a lawful basis in the legitimate interests of the Church. These include:**

- **Enabling housebound parishioners to engage in worship from home**
- **Enabling relatives and friends to engage with baptisms, weddings, and funerals if they cannot attend in person**
- **Using the Blessed Sacrament as a focus of prayer for those who are unable to get to church**
- **Evangelisation by enabling those who would not usually come to church to engage with acts of worship**

**Livestreaming takes place over the internet via YouTube and Facebook and recordings will remain available for 28 days. Livestreams and recordings can be viewed online by anyone who wishes to do so.**

**The 10.30am Mass on Sundays is always streamed. Other regular weekend and weekday Masses are not normally streamed. Special occasions, funerals and holy days may be streamed. Please check the newsletter.**

**If you do not wish to appear on the livestream, you are advised to avoid sitting in the first two rows in front of the altar. Please be aware that you may appear briefly from behind if you come up for communion.**
