Christmas Events

• Altar Servers Party

This year we are going to invite the older children to join the Altar Servers Party (year 4 and above). Formation for Altar Servers will take place before the party. The planned Reconciliation Service will take place after the party. Food is simple Pizza and nibbles.

Children's Party

Planned for 22/12/24, 12.30 to 2pm. Entertainer booked; Liz is short of help. Sharon offered to help. Liz thinks parents will stay to help. Need to clear coffee after Mass by 12.30pm. Elf is

bringing Santa presents this year. Evening will be planned to wrap presents once they have been obtained.

• Children's Christmas Mass

Next year will be under Children's Ministry and Youth Ministry. Form already on Website for parents to sign children up who want to participate.

• Epiphany Meal

The meal is on 5/1/25. Limited to 50. For people living alone and Seniors.

Open to the community. We cannot arrange transport. Meal at 1pm; 2 courses Christmas dinner and pudding. After Christmas seems to be a good idea, to give people something to look forward to. Will need to be published before Christmas. Form to be on website in a couple of weeks. Sharon to cost meal and it will be by donation or sponsor a plate. Cameron (a professional chief) will be present to ensure good standards.

I will request help when I know what the vegetable situation is after Christmas.

• Cake Stall and Raffle

The Seniors are planning a cake stall in the Spring. Discussed whether to have a cake stall and raffle before Christmas.

Discussed use of money raised by raffle. It was felt that the raffle should support the Epiphany meal or a local homeless charity. To be discussed with Fr Anthony. There seems to be a question about the Salesian university still being active. After further discussion it was felt that money raised could be used to support further social events if Fr Anthony wants to keep as many events free of charge as possible.
